Dear Judge Turner:

I don't suppose you remember my name. More than four years ago, on April 25, 2005, I contacted you after learning that Judge William M. Ray, II, filed a contempt of court charge against attorney Christopher A. Frazier for his misconduct in my criminal case. Judge Ray's contempt charge was not levied in haste, but rather, after continuous misconduct of Mr. Frazier which only ended when, following a succession of earlier lies, Mr. Frazier feigned an attempted suicide only hours before my trial. After filing his contempt of court charge, Judge Ray was recused from the matter and the contempt charge was appropriately reassigned. Mistakenly, the matter was assigned to you.

Though I contacted you on April 25th requesting an opportunity to be heard by the Court, you ignored my request and dismissed Judge Ray's contempt charge on April 27th. You later denied my subsequent Petition for Hearing on the matter. Rather than accept your responsibility to conduct a fair and impartial hearing to determine what penalties, if any, Mr. Frazier should have faced for his misconduct in my criminal case, you allowed Mr. Frazier to continue practicing law while he thumbed his nose at you, me, and the entire judicial system. You should be ashamed.

I am pleased to report that, despite your failure to act, the State Bar of Georgia has disbarred Mr. Frazier and awarded repayment of money I lost to him. I hope my letter to you will awaken your sense of responsibility to the community you serve.

Judge yourself accordingly.

Dear Honorable Judge Turner:

I am writing with regard of the captioned matter and in request for your assistance.

On March 14, 2005, I suffered the loss of co-counsel, Mr. Christopher A. Frazier, for my criminal defense in the captioned matter. Prior to this date, Mr. Frazier and I endured a difficult relationship due to his repetitive failures to perform and other related concerns. Due to Mr. Frazier's absence from my criminal trial, I incurred a substantial additional expense for the legal fees of attorney Doug Peters, employed to fulfill Mr. Frazier's role.

On April 25, 2005, upon discovering Honorable Judge Ray's Notice in the Clerk's court file, I contacted you in request for an opportunity to be heard by the Court and to participate in any formal or informal hearings for the contempt of court matter. I submitted my communication to you by facsimile on April 25, 2005 and by U.S. Mail. On May 7, 2005, I received a copy of your Order, executed on April 27, 2005, dismissing Judge Ray's Notice of Contempt Charge Against Chris Frazier, Esq. Unfortunately, I was denied any opportunity to be heard by the Court and to participate in any hearings for the matter prior to issuance of your Order.

Today, I will file with the Clerk of Court my Petition for Hearing on Order Dismissing Notice of Contempt Charge Against Christopher A. Frazier, Esq.

In writing you, I request your consideration to offer an opportunity to be heard and to participate in any formal or informal hearings regarding the contempt of court charge against Mr. Christopher A. Frazier.
